

Pathway for Response to Bluegrey spot

	Presenting Situation	Action
1.	Blue-grey spot observed, use Professional Judgement and assessment of:	 Ethnicity. Midwifery documentation. Child and family circumstances. Clearly document – size, colour, position of the Blue-grey spot. Re-visit & Re-assess in 5 days.
2.	Blue-grey spot suspected but practitioner unsure:	 Follow action as above. Contact GP and arrange a same day appointment – it will not be necessary to remain with the family in this situation. Follow up outcome of GP appointment on the same day.
3.	Unexplained mark to infant:	 Follow process for Bruising and Injuries in Children Not Independently Mobile. Remain with child and family and await Children's Services.
