CLINICAL	ORGANISATIONAL
Unexpected death	Inappropriate/lack of professional
	involvement
Loss of fetal remains	Equipment/facilities failure
Failure to give Anti D	Patient identification issues
Delay or missed diagnosis e.g. ectopic	Failure to follow protocol
Damage to bowel/bladder/major blood vessel/uterus	Postponement of elective procedures
Deep vein thrombosis/pulmonary embolus	Communication failures
Severe infection	Staffing issues
Abdominal/vaginal wound complications	Potentially Inappropriate admissions
Haemorrhage requiring blood transfusion	Clinic cancelled at less than 6 weeks notice
Failed operative procedure (e.g. abortion,	Professional disagreement over case
sterilization, laparoscopy	management
Un-planned readmission	Failure to escalate or request assistance
Drug incident	Complications of anaesthesia
Patient non compliance	Delay following call for assistance
Problems related to medical/expectant	Infection control/cleanliness issues
management of miscarriage/ERPC/MTOP/STOP	
Unplanned return to theatre	
Unplanned HDU/ITU admission	
Deviation from planned surgery	
Retained swab/instrument	
Ovarian hyperstimulation (assisted conception)
