



Molar Pregnancy Clinical Pathway 2025

Suspected Molar Pregnancy

- Provide Patient Information Leaflet
- Book and consent for ERPC
- Take bloods for FBC/G+S.

Surgical Management

- ERPC (avoid syntocinon if possible.)
- Send Histology as USC. Results to PF/CK
- Secondary deposits must not be biopsied (significant haemorrhage risk)
- Surgeon to Inform EPAU of patient details and book hCG in 2 weeks.

Molar Pregnancy Confirmed (Histology)

- EPAU team/ PF/CK to Inform Patient.
- PF/CK to confirm consent for Charing Cross registration and send referral within 5 weeks of ERPC. (On Call Consultant in their absence.)
- Provide written info if not already given.

Follow-up through EPAU

- Blood samples for hCG taken in EPAU (only using kit sent by CHX to patient)
- Patient to contact EPAU with any symptoms./concerns

Charing Cross Follow Up

Persistent high hCG/bleeding/queries - discuss with CHX **before** repeat ERPC/biopsy.

CHX will contact local clinician if needs further ERPC or chemotherapy

Chemotherapy regimen from CHX needs to be prescribed on local drug chart.
