Abstract Submission instructions:

- Abstract to be typed in Arial font (10 point).
- Maximum word count 300
- Ensure abstract does not contain spelling, grammatical errors as it will be reproduced exactly as submitted.

The abstract must be as informative as possible and should include:

- A title that clearly indicates the nature of the study. (Capitalize the entire title)
- Abbreviations should be avoided in titles
- Authors' names in full and institution must be shown. (The name of the presenting author must be indicated)
- State study objective clearly
- State methods used
- Summarise results
- State study conclusions

Prizes will be awarded for the best poster presentation and the best oral presentation by a trainee.

Closing date for abstract submission is **29th September 2024**. Successful presenters will be notified by mail.
